Debrief of 2015 Youth Summit

Ms. Tignac reminded the Youth Council that they are expected to debrief the City Council on issues and concerns identified during the 2015 Youth Summit. As a tool to assist with finalizing the event debrief, a handout was distributed listing each group topic, including issues and solutions discussed. Nick Steinwender and Leah Nohrenberg led an activity to prioritize top issues of concern and corresponding solutions.

Youth Council members then discussed and selected their top issues of concern.

<u>ACTION</u>: A motion to approve select issues and proposed solutions to be presented to the City Council was made by Prachi Patel and seconded by Vardaan Bal.

Youth Council vote: 19 Ayes; 0 Noes; 0 abstentions The motion passed.

The following issues and proposed solutions will be presented to the City Council:

1. Group Topic: Teen Activities

Issue: Limited teen activities

Solution: Continue working closely with the Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District to offer recommendations for teen programming ideas; including a teen music festival.

2. Group Topic: Bullying

Issue: Lack of cultural diversity

Solution: Increase cultural and social diversity awareness education to students at earlier ages; such as elementary school.

3. Group Topic: Environmental Concerns

Issue: On-campus litter

Solution: Promote clean campus competitions among schools.

4. Group Topic: Crime/Gang Activity/Violence

Issue: Crime prevention awareness among teens.

Solution: Increase awareness among teen population regarding the Simi Valley Police Department's crime prevention media, such as NIXLE and recent mobile app.

5. Group Topic: Homelessness

Issue: Stigma surrounding mental health challenges.

Solution: Increase awareness of services and help available for those with mental health challenges.

Group Topic: Bullying Issue: Identified Bullies

Solution: Recommend a mandatory bullying awareness course for

students identified as the aggressor in reported bullying

incidents.
