1. Call to Order/Welcome/Pledge of Allegiance

Chair Don Diamond called the meeting to order at 7:31 p.m. Secretary Tim Donis confirmed that a quorum was present.

2. Agenda Review

Chair Don Diamond requested to move Item 8a. (Review of Proposed Revisions to the City's Sign Ordinance) before Item 6a. (The Simi Valley Police Department's Detective Unit). By consensus of the Executive Board, the agenda was approved as revised.

A motion was made by Jeff Faulwell and seconded by George Apodac to approve the April 9, 2015 minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

8. New Business

a. Review of Proposed Revisions to the City's Sign Ordinance

Peter Lyons, Director of Environmental Services, provided an overview of the City's current temporary sign ordinance and what is proposed once the ordinance sunsets later this year. He noted that the City Council had requested input from the Neighborhood Councils on the proposed revisions. Of particular interest was whether they felt it was appropriate to discontinue the use of feather signs and to increase the size and amount of monument signs.

Questions and comments from the Executive Board/responses from the applicant:

Will feather signs no longer be allowed when the current temporary sign ordinance sunsets later this year?

Yes, the temporary sign regulations will return to those used in 2010, which do not allow feather signs.

One person expressed concern for small businesses, in that they should be able to continue using the feather signs since they are dependent upon their specific shopping center to increase the size and number of monument signs.

Two people questioned the necessity of adding more monument signs since there is no data to show that an increase in the number of monument signs would increase business in shopping centers.

Upon conclusion of the discussion, the following motion was made by Debbie Thomas and seconded by Jamie Extract:

MOTION: Recommend that the Planning Commission approve the proposed revisions to the City's Sign Ordinance with a modification to allow feather signs remain an option for businesses.
