Selection of the 2016 Youth Summit Theme

 - a. Discussion of Another Potential 2016 Youth Summit Motivational Speaker

Youth Summit Committee Chair Nicolas Mintzer stated that another potential Youth Summit motivational speaker was presented to the Youth Summit Committee. He gave a brief bio on Angela Ruggiero, Member of the 2015 Hockey Hall of Fame and four time Olympian, having won the gold medal in 1998, silver in 2002 and 2010, and bronze in 2006.

Drug Abuse Awareness, by Julia Feig, Director of Emergency Service, Simi Valley Hospital

Registered Nurse Feig gave a brief presentation on her background, general statistics of substance-related emergency room visits by teens and young adults, and an overview of what she covers in her drug abuse presentations that she provides to ninth grade students in Simi Valley.

Nurse Feig stated the importance of education for drug and alcohol prevention and noted that in Simi Valley, marijuana use is seen more than alcohol use among teens.

Youth Council members recommended offering the drug abuse awareness presentations to eight grade students versus ninth grade, to target before the move on to high school.

9. Representative Reports

Alex Judge announced that Adrian Schemm, Jasanpreet and she attended the Rotary Club of Simi Sunrise's Youth Empowerment Summit on November 7, 2015. Ms. Judge announced that she was nominated to attend the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) program in the spring of 2016.

Emily Ramirez reported that she and 14 other Royal High School Air Force JROTC cadets volunteered at the Secretary of Defense Forum on Saturday, November 7, 2015, at the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum.

Nicolas Mintzer announced that he was nominated to receive the Daily Point of Light Award on December 15, 2015, as well as a Presidential Service Award for 100 plus volunteer hours.

Prachi Patel stated that she and Leah Nohrenberg attended the Task Force on Homelessness meeting November 12, 2015, and gave a brief meeting report.
