a. The City's Cultural Arts Center: 20 Years of Entertainment

David Ralphe, General Manager of the Cultural Arts Center (CAC), gave a brief overview of the history of the CAC. The building was previously a church, a funeral home, and a temple. The CAC produces high quality productions with local performers. Admission is \$24 for adults, \$22 for seniors and \$18 for kids. There are also tickets available for students and teachers at a discounted price of \$10 and can be purchased five minutes before a show, based on space available.
