City of Thousand Oaks Community Internships Training Youth (C.I.T.Y.) Program by Francine Sprigel

Francine Sprigel, City of Thousand Oaks Associate Analyst, gave a brief overview of the City of Thousand Oaks' Youth Commission and a brief history of the C.I.T.Y. program, including successes and challenges.

Ms. Sprigel announced that this summer 50 internship openings were available compared to 19 the program's first year. She discussed program details including timeline and associated events, including the C.I.T.Y. Internship Fair scheduled on Tuesday, February 28, 2017.

Ms. Tignac thanked Simi Valley Chamber of Commerce President and CEO Rana Ghadban for making an announcement at the podium promoting that employers register to attend the YES Job and Career Expo during the February 10, 2017 Chamber Networking Breakfast.

Ms. Tignac reported which employers had already registered to attend the Expo. Gloria Bowman stated that she had contacted Dutton Plumbing, Pacific Care and AE Com to attend the Expo.

Jennifer Wigdor recommended that the Expo banners be displayed at the high schools two weeks prior to the event.

Members discussed additional marketing ideas to promote the event to out-of-school youth, such as posting flyers on Starbuck's Coffee Community Bulletin Boards.
