# Background



CITY OF SIMI VALLEY

- ▶ **October 15, 2018** – Public Hearing #2, including presentation by City’s demographic consultant (NDC), to receive public testimony on district composition and criteria and review tools available to the public to submit proposed district maps
- ▶ **September 17, 2018 – November 6, 2018**  
Mapping tools available to the public to submit proposed district maps
- ▶ **November 6, 2018** – Maps posted online, and at City Hall & Library for public review

# Public Hearing #3

- ▶ Receive presentation by National Demographics on:
  - Draft voting District maps and Submitter Comments from citizens
  - Draft maps prepared by demographer
  - Draft District map election “sequencing” options
- ▶ Receive public testimony on draft maps
- ▶ Provide direction to NDC on desired map revisions
- ▶ Set Public Hearing #4 for November 26

# Maps Submitted



- ▶ 15 proposed District maps submitted
  - One Map (#603) did not meet basic qualifications
  - One Map (#602) was submitted by multiple individuals
  - One proposal (3-District scenario) was submitted and not considered based on Gov't Code restrictions
  - Six maps prepared by NDC (405, 501, 502, 604, 701, 702)
- ▶ Submitter Comments are included for information

# Direction requested



CITY OF SIMI VALLEY

- ▶ How many districts should be formed?
  - 4 or 6 Districts with Mayor directly elected (at-large)
  - 5 or 7 Districts with a rotational Mayor (by-district)
- ▶ Where should the District lines be drawn?
- ▶ “Sequence” of elections for the district composition selected
  - Which districts will have an election in 2020 / 2022
