4. Correspondence

Ms. Tignac stated that on May 10, 2021, she had received correspondence from former YES Advisory Board member John Baxter requesting 20 YES Interview Skills Workbooks for a workshop to be presented to homeless job seekers at the Simi Valley Samaritan Center. She also reported that on May 17, 2021, she led the Job Day workshop at the Samaritan Center.

7. New Business

a. Debrief of the 2021 YES Job and Career Expo

Ms. Tignac reported that the virtual Job Expo webpage was still live and available for job seekers per multiple employer requests and would stay open through the end of June. Ms. Tignac shared page metrics that 704 page views were received. She also indicated how many views were made to each employer's page, with 145, the highest number of views, going to Sierra Canyon Day Camp. Longtime Job and Career Expo employers preferred attending the past YES Job and Career Expos over virtual, having an in-person event, but appreciated the virtual event.

Board members discussed their experiences volunteering for the daily virtual Live Chat and the two virtual Mock Interview sessions. Ms. Tignac reported that seven job seekers participated in the mock interviews, with each receiving two to three interviews. Overall feedback was that the job seekers and Board members felt the whole experience was excellent.

Connor Kubeisy shared pre-COVID and current youth unemployment statistics; 8% pre-COVID, 27% during COVID, and currently sitting at 11%, noting that the numbers were improving.

b. Discussion of YES Programming Ideas for Summer 2021

Ms. Tignac gave a brief overview of "pre-COVID" YES programming with typical workshops held at the Simi Valley Public Library.

With the anticipated June 15, 2021 re-opening, Board members discussed holding an in-person Resume Writing Workshop paired with mock interviews.

Mailani McNabb-Robinson offered to host the workshop and mock interviews at the Boys and Girls Club of Moorpark and Simi Valley.

The following Board members volunteered to serve on a subcommittee to develop the workshop presentation; Ryan Fowler, Tim Harrington, Mailani McNabb-Robinson and Rocky Rhodes.

<u>Action Item</u>: Ms. Tignac to coordinate with the subcommittee in hosting the workshop.

c. Discussion of Scheduling a YES Advisory Board Meeting on Wednesday, August 18, 2021

With consensus, members agreed to have the first YES Advisory Board meeting of the 2021-2 school year on Wednesday, August 18, 2021.

8. Youth Employment Service Advisory Board Reports and Comments

Gloria Bowman reported that swim lessons will begin again in July at the City of Calabasas' Tennis and Swim Center, though they are very short staffed and needing to hire.

Startup Simi Committee Chair Rob West reminded Board members that the Startup Simi next Inspire Entrepreneurship Speaker Series event would be held virtually on Tuesday, May 25, 2021. Mr. West asked everyone to promote the event and to visit www.startupsimi.com to register.

Samantha Shapiro announced that the Simi Valley Chamber of Commerce would host a Boomers and Beyond Expo from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., on Saturday, May 22, 2021, in their parking lot.
