6. Informational Presentation

The City of Simi Valley Code Enforcement's Role in Community Preservation

Jesus Salcido, Code Compliance Officer, gave the presentation. He explained that Code Compliance implements community goals such as protecting property values and addressing quality of life issues through the enforcement of the City's Municipal Code. The focus is on education as many individuals may not be aware of the rules and have no idea they are in violation until they are informed.

The majority of enforcement is reactive. Code compliance officers respond to complaints from citizens, whose names are always kept confidential. During COVID however, residential enforcement was paused other than life safety issues. Instead, resources were redirected to support businesses and educate community members. In mid-2021, active enforcement resumed.
