 - a. The City of Simi Valley Code Enforcement's Role in Community Preservation

Trinece Rose-Bandy, Code Compliance Officer, gave the presentation. She explained that Code Compliance implements community goals such as protecting property values and addressing quality of life issues through the enforcement of the City's Municipal Code. The focus is on education as many individuals may not be aware of the rules and have no idea they are in violation until they are informed.

The majority of enforcement is reactive. Code compliance officers respond to complaints from citizens, whose names are always kept confidential. During COVID however, residential enforcement was paused other than life safety issues. Instead, resources were redirected to support businesses and educate community members. In mid-2021, active enforcement resumed.

b. Simi Valley's Hazard Mitigation Plan and Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)

Eileen Connors, Emergency Services Manager, gave the presentation. She provided an overview of the Hazard Mitigation Plan. It emphasizes predisaster planning for natural and man-made disasters with an emphasis on strong, integrated state and local planning.

She also discussed the CERT Academy, which is taught by the Ventura County Fire Department. It is considered the foundation of Simi Valley's emergency preparedness. Anyone 18 years or older who lives/works in Simi Valley is eligible to attend. It is for people who want to serve the community by assisting their family and neighbors during emergencies or disaster situations.
