2. Agenda Review

3. Approval of Minutes from May 18, 2022

Ms. Tignac reported that correspondence had been received from the City Manager's Office regarding interest in participating in the City Expo in conjunction with the Chamber of Commerce's Biannual Street Fair on Saturday, October 29, 2022.

6. Informational Presentation

a. Overview of the YES Advisory Board

Ms. Tignac presented the history of the YES program from its inception in 1970 and the establishment of the Advisory Board in 1982. She also highlighted program firsts and statistics throughout the decades.

8. New Business

a. Election of Officers

Ryan Fowler reviewed the responsibilities of each position and gave an overview of his experience as Chair. The following ran unopposed for their respective positions: Gloria Bowman for Chair, John Tolson for Vice Chair, and Bobby Calderon for Secretary.

YES Advisory Board vote: 12 Ayes; 0 Noes; 0 Abstentions The motion passed unanimously.

b. Debrief of the YES Summer Workshop Series

Ms. Tignac reported that the four YES workshops held during the summer were very successful. She thanked all of the YES Board members that lead the workshops with her.

She stated that the Library staff were extremely pleased with the turnout of teen participants.

Ms. Wigdor recommended distributing flyers for the summer workshop series to the schools next year as early as April to ensure promotion to students.

c. Discussion of the Simi Valley Unified School District's Annual College Fair on Wednesday, September 14, 2022, from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Mrs. Wigdor clarified that the SVUSD College Fair hours to be 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The tables will be located on Royal High School's campus and will be first come, first serve.

ACTION: A motion to approve participating in the Simi Valley Unified School District's College Fair on September 14, 2022 was made by Anthony Angelini and seconded by Rocky Rhodes.

YES Advisory Board vote: 11 Ayes; 0 Noes; 0 Abstentions; The motion passed unanimously.

d. Update on Startup Simi

John Tolson reported that Mike Panesis, Executive Director, the Steven Dorfman Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship at California Lutheran

University, attended the last Startup Simi committee and discussed the Techstars Startup Weekend program, a three day entrepreneur competition. CLU's HUB101 is scheduled to host its next Startup Weekend in October.

Ms. Tignac encouraged all board members to promote and attend the Startup Simi's next Inspire Entrepreneurship Speaker Series event scheduled on August 23, 2022, featuring new YES Advisory Board member Marc Netka, CEO and Co-Founder of STS Education.

Ryan Fowler thanked Board members and Reagan Student Leadership Program mentors Gloria Bowman, Tim Harrington and Kristin Tignac for helping SLP students this summer.

John Tolson announced that Chamber of Commerce would host a Job Fair in the closed Macy's building on August 30, 2022. He asked that board members share the flyer to help promote the event.

Gloria Bowman stated that she was looking forward to working with everyone on the board this year.
