6. Informational Presentation

The Simi Valley Samaritan Center

Annika Sumby, Executive Director, gave the presentation. In early 2022, 141 homeless individuals were counted in Simi Valley, though the number is most likely double by this time. The Samaritan Center's day time drop-in services include meals, a food pantry, showers, laundry, and clothing. They manage winter overnight shelter services. They also offer full case management services for those who want to become self-supporting and independent. These services encompass assistance with finding a job and housing, identification (ID) vouchers and life skills mentoring. Over the last year, they placed nine people in drug and alcohol treatment, helped 14 people find employment and assisted seven people in finding housing.
