#### 6. Continued Business

a. Discussion of the Annual Talent Show on Thursday, April 6, 2023

Talent Show Chair Rikka Tignac reported that the final line-up of 22 competitive acts and six noncompetitive acts were set to perform at this year's Talent Show. They also announced that Talent Show tickets sold out the day before.

All Youth Council members were reminded of their assigned roles for the event and the Talent Show run-through and sound check would be held on Wednesday, April 5, 2023, from 3:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. All members and event volunteers were required to attend that night. Ms. Tignac confirmed that dinner would be provided.

Youth Council members discussed cash prize amounts for the winners of each category and selected \$200.00 for solo act categories, \$300.00 for group act categories, and \$500.00 for the People's Choice award winner.

Members also selected the dress code for the event of dark pants and dark polo shirts.

Social Media Chair Ella McCrossan asked that all members and volunteers take photos, vertical direction preferred for use as social media content.

Ms. Tignac thanked all of the members that brought in raffle and silent auction items.

b. Discussion of the Teen Wellness Night on Friday, May 19, 2023

Substance Use Prevention and Teen Wellness Night Committee Chair Anika Nedunuri reported that there were still only three vendors registered to participate in the Teen Wellness Night event; Baha'i Faith of Simi Valley, Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District, and Simi Valley Unified School District.
