3. Approval of Minutes from April 4, 2023

4. Correspondence

Ms. Tignac announced that Youth Council received a request from Purvi Pathak, SKY Breath Meditation Teacher, Sri Sri Yoga Teacher, and Art of Living Volunteer, in regards to collaborating with the Youth Council in hosting a Power of Breathing and Meditation session.

Public Statements/Comments

The students in attendance introduced themselves, along with their grade levels and schools they attend.

6. Continued Business

a. Discussion of the Teen Wellness Night on Friday, May 19, 2023

Substance Use Prevention and Teen Wellness Night Committee Chair Anika Nedunuri reported that there were six vendors registered to participate in the Teen Wellness Night event; a Girl Scout Ambassador, Baha'i Faith of Simi Valley, Los Robles Health System, Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District, Simi Valley Unified School District, and the Art of Living Foundation and International Association for Human Values. Anika strongly encouraged all members to reach out to clubs, organizations, and businesses to ask them to host booths at the event. Members discussed the items that the TUPE grant would cover, such as water bottles, journals, wellness stickers, stress balls and wellness bracelets.

Mental Health Committee Chair Abhishek Jagannathan reminded members that Youth Council would promote an "unplugged" day to be held on May 18, 2023, with an opportunity drawing of Beats Headphones selected from the students that participated in the unplugged day to be given out at the Teen Wellness Night and/or a prize given to the person with the lowest daily or weekly screen time usage at the event. Members discussed ideas for the prize.

ACTION: A motion to approve spending up to \$500.00 to purchase the incentive items for the unplugged day was made by Anika Nedunuri and seconded by Jasleen Khangura.

b. Discussion of the Mental Health Awareness Month Campaign

Mental Health Committee Chair Abhishek Jagannathan stated that the Youth Council had the opportunity to attend and accept the May as Mental Health Awareness Month Proclamation at the May 1, 2023 City Council Meeting.

The following Youth Council members volunteered to attend with Mr. Jagannathan; Serena Jetely, Jasleen Khangura, Christopher Kricorian, and Nandhiha Krishnamoorthi.

Mr. Jagannathan reported that Purvi Pathak and Dr. Jeffrey Knepper, from the Art of Living Foundation, had attended the last committee meeting to discuss the Power of Breathing and Meditation workshop they would like to cohost. The Foundation will not only have a booth at the Teen Wellness Night; they will also host a time specific breathing and meditation session.

7. New Business

a. Recap of the Annual Talent Show held on Thursday, April 6, 2023

Talent Show Chair Rikka Tignac thanked the Talent Show committee and all Youth Council members for their hard work hosting the annual Talent Show. They announced that the Talent Show raised \$2,890.00.

Rikka led the event debrief with members, highlighting the positives of the sold out event and addressing challenges.

The following recommendations for next year were mentioned; for all members to act professionally at all times and to fully understand their assigned roles, all acts to turn in audio tracks as mp3 files only and to use specific naming conventions for files, to reduce acts from leaving the green room have audio of the live performances relayed into the room, have more seating available in the green room, have more volunteers to help with raffle and silent auction during the intermissions, affix the people's choice voting tickets to the programs, when asking acts for their bios, also ask for their on-stage introductions, have a strict cap on number of acts allowed, and to have additional trainings or crew runthroughs so that everyone knows what they should be doing the night of the event.
