c. Discussion of the Youth Council's 2023 Suicide Prevention Rock Painting Night on Friday, September 22, 2023

Ms. Tignac reported that Boba Time had not responded to her requests to host a restaurant fundraising event on September 22, 2023. She stated that she had put in a request to the backup, Yogurtland, which she immediately received notice that the request had been accepted.

Youth Council Chair Abhishek Jagannathan gave a brief overview of the event and funds raised in the past given to suicide prevention organizations. Due to lack of confirmation from Boba Time, Youth Council members decided to hold the restaurant fundraiser at Yogurtland from 11:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m., the day of the event.

Jasleen Khangura volunteered to create the flyer for the Rock Painting Night.

<u>ACTION</u>: A motion to approve the Yogurtland Restaurant Fundraiser with funds raised to be donated to a local mental health organization was made by Claire Menges and seconded by Saydee Ro.
