2. Agenda Review

Acting Youth Council Chair James LeQuang asked if there were any changes to the agenda. There being none, by consensus the agenda was approved as presented.

3. Approval of Minutes from June 4, 2024

Acting Youth Council Chair Nandhiha Krishnamoorthi asked members if they had reviewed the minutes from June 4, 2024, and then requested a motion for approval.

ACTION: A motion to approve the June 4, 2024, minutes as written was made by Advaith Nair and seconded by Ethan Bhat.

Youth Council Vote: 14 Ayes; 0 Noes; 7 Abstentions

The motion passed.

4. Correspondence

Acting Youth Council Chair Prithika Bijith asked if any correspondence had been received.

Mr. Fowler stated that he had received an email from Children Now inviting the Youth Council to participate in their virtual Summit for Student Leaders on October 20, 2024, from 10:00am to 3:00pm.

5. Public Statements/Comments

Acting Youth Council Chair Nishta Kubsad reviewed the public statement and comment procedure.

Anarosa Estevez from the Simi Valley Cultural Arts Center Foundation introduced herself and gave a brief overview about the Foundation. She shared that the Cultural Arts Center was hosting a Hispanic Heritage Festival on September 28,2024, from 10:00 a.m.to 4:00 p.m., featuring vendors, food, arts & crafts, a documentary screening, and dancers. Mrs. Estevez invited the Youth Council to volunteer at this event if they were interested.

Sanchita Karthik from the Simi Valley Cultural Arts Center Foundation stated that the Cultural Arts Center was also hosting a Colors of India event on October 15th and invited the Youth Council members to volunteer at that event as well.

Two students in attendance introduced themselves, along with their grade levels and schools they attend.

6. Informational Presentations

a. Youth Council Coordinator Ryan Fowler shared information on Youth Council accomplishments and annual events from the 2022-2023 term.

Advaith Nair, Nandhiha Krishnamoorthi, Tanvi Ijju and Abhishek Humbe presented a slide show of various accomplishments and events held during the 2022-23 Youth Council term. They provided detailed descriptions of the purpose, outcome, and roles Youth Council members had in coordinating each event.

7. Continued Business

Youth Council Coordinator Ryan Fowler stated that there were no continued business items to discuss.

8. New Business

a. Discussion of the Youth Summit on October 11, 2024

Acting Youth Council Chair Advaith Nair reviewed the purpose and format of the Youth Summit event. Mr. Nair shared updates from the Youth Summit committee including that a sign up/registration form had been created as a Google form, Jasleen Khangura had created a promotional flyer for the event and just needed to add the link to the registration form once approved, and the committee had selected recommendations for breakout group topics and catering options, but he did not have those topics or options with him at this meeting. Youth Council Coordinator Ryan Fowler asked if they had selected dignitaries to invite to the Youth Summit lunch yet, which the Youth Council had not. Mr. Nair led a discussion of which dignitaries to invite, and it was suggested that the potential dignitaries' background and

experience align with the breakout group topics. Mr. Fowler was asked to research past dignitaries and bring the list to the next meeting.

There being no objections, acting Youth Council Chair Advaith Nair continued the discussion regarding Youth Summit breakout group topics, catering options, and dignitaries to the September 3, 2024, Youth Council meeting.

Action Items: Mr. Fowler to submit registration form and promotional flyer for approval, and research past Youth Summit dignitary attendees and bring to the September 3, 2024, Youth Council meeting.

b. Discussion of the Youth Council's 2024 Suicide Prevention Campaign

Acting Youth Council Chair Jasleen Khangura led the discussion to gather suicide prevention campaign ideas. Ms. Khangura gave a brief history and overview of the Youth Council's previous Suicide Prevention campaigns.

Youth Council members reviewed the potential dates to host the Rock Painting Night with the Simi Valley Public Library for suicide prevention awareness and selected Friday, September 20, 2024, as the date with the least amount of school conflicts. Youth Council members expressed interest in holding a fundraiser at Yogurtland on September 20, 2024, in conjunction with Rock Painting Night. Natalie Nguyen volunteered to research non-profits that address suicide prevention and mental health and bring a list of potential donation recipients to the September 3, 2024, Youth Council meeting.

Additional ideas were discussed including incorporating suicide prevention social media content, sending representatives to attend the Annual Preventing Suicide Forum, and having representatives attend the City Council meeting on Monday, September 9, 2024, to accept the proclamation proclaiming September 2024 as Suicide Prevention Month.

ACTION: A motion to approve a Suicide Prevention Campaign to include a Rock Painting Night on Friday, September 20, 2024, a fundraiser at Yogurtland on September 20, 2024, to have Youth Council representatives attend the September 9, 2024, City Council meeting to accept the proclamation proclaiming September 2024 as Suicide Prevention Month, to send Youth Council representatives to attend the Annual Preventing Suicide Forum, and to develop Suicide Prevention social media content was made by Advaith Nair and seconded by James LeQuang.

Youth Council Vote: 23 Ayes; 0 Noes; 0 Abstentions
The motion passed.

There being no objections, acting Youth Council Chair Jasleen Khangura continued the discussion to finalize the Rock Painting and Yogurtland event details to the September 3, 2024, Youth Council meeting.

Action Items: Mr. Fowler to check availability of Yogurtland for September 20, 2024, fundraiser and book if able to.

c. Selection of the Youth Council Informational Report Presenter to the City Council on Monday, September 9, 2024

Acting Youth Council Chair Tanvi Ijju reviewed the roles and responsibilities of the Informational Report presenters, including completing a draft speech by September 3, 2024. The following members volunteered to present: Chloe Drury and Natalie Nguyen. After a hand vote, Ms. Drury was selected as the presenter for the Youth Council Informational Report to the City Council on Monday, September 9, 2024.

ACTION: A motion to approve Chloe Drury as the presenter for the Youth Council Informational Report to the City Council on Monday, September 9, 2024, was made by Saydee Ro and seconded by Natalie Nguyen.

Youth Council Vote: 23 Ayes; 0 Noes; 0 Abstentions

The motion passed.

d. Selection of the Youth Council Representative to the YES Advisory Board

Youth Council Acting Chair Kalyssa Ro gave a brief review of the Youth Council Representative to the Youth Employment Service (YES) Advisory Board. Rithmika Naveen and Chloe Drury shared about their experiences previously serving on the YES Advisory Board. The following members volunteered to serve as the representative: Rithmika Naveen, Natalie Nguyen, Nicole Kim. Nicole Kim received the most votes and was selected to serve as the Youth Council Representative to the YES Advisory Board.

<u>ACTION</u>: A motion to approve Nicole Kim as the Youth Council representative to the YES Advisory Board was made by Ethan Bhat and seconded by Nishta Kubsad.

Youth Council vote: 23 Ayes; 0 Noes; 0 Abstentions

e. Discussion and Selection of the Youth Council Outreach Item(s)

Acting Youth Council Chair Abhishek Humbe led a brainstorm session to determine Youth Council members' preferred outreach item for the 2023-24 term. Members discussed exploring a hoodie or sweatshirt option, along with a polo shirt. After discussion, a consensus was reached to purchase polo shirts. Members then discussed the color of the polo shirt, with black, dark blue (navy) and dark purple being the most popular options. A hand vote was held and dark blue (navy) received the most votes.
