All Block Parties must have written permission from the Police Department. Request must be submitted no later than Friday, July 12, 2013.

## CITY OF SIMI VALLEY • BLOCK PARTY PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

The City of Simi Valley supports family oriented activities, such as block parties. An Encroachment Permit is needed whenever a public street (or segment of a street) is going to be closed for such a function. Please review the following requirements:

1. The Block Party applicant must submit a completed application and petition (see attached forms) to the Police Department's Records Unit at least **two weeks** before the intended event. This time is needed to review the location, evaluate the effect on area traffic and public safety, obtain administrative approval, and prepare the Encroachment Permit.
2. The attached petition must be signed by a majority of the residents directly affected by the proposed temporary street closure. **In addition to obtaining the required signatures, the applicant must notify all other residents of the event.** The attached **Notice of Block Party** form may be duplicated and used for this purpose. In order to minimize potential inconvenience, all required notifications must be completed at least one week before the scheduled block party.
3. Subsequent to permit approval, the applicant shall agree to obtain and place five (5) City approved Type II barricades across the normally unobstructed end(s) of the street (see attached diagram). A C 2 "Road Closed" sign shall be affixed to the middle barricade and visible to all approaching traffic. Required barricades and signs are available at local rental companies. **No other means shall be used to block the roadway.**
4. An approved block party may begin no earlier than 10:00 am and must conclude no later than 10:00 pm.
5. Any change in the date of the scheduled block party must be approved by the Police Department.
6. The applicant agrees that the Police Department and/or the Ventura County Fire Department shall retain the right to terminate the Block Party at any time.
7. The applicant shall accept full responsibility for site clean-up and repair/restoration of the public right-of-way.
8. A non-refundable processing fee of seventy-five dollars (**\$72.00**) shall be paid to the City of Simi Valley when the block party application, petition, and **signed** Encroachment Permit form are submitted.**(NO FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR NATIONAL NIGHT OUT)**
9. **Restrictions:** Section 5-3.01 of the Simi Valley Municipal Code prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages in public; this includes front yards as well as the (closed) roadway. Section 7802.3 of the Uniform Fire Code further prohibits the use and/or possession of any fireworks without a permit.
10. **Any violation of the Uniform Fire Code relating to fireworks will make the requested street ineligible for future Block Party permits for a period of five (5) years.**

## Block Party Conditions

1. The applicant shall place five (5) City approved Type II barricades across the normally unobstructed end(s) of the street. A C 2 "Road Closed" sign shall be affixed to the middle barricade and must be visible to all approaching traffic.
2. The barricades must be easily moved in the case of an emergency.
3. An unobstructed 15' fire lane must be maintained along the closed portion of the roadway. Vehicles, play equipment or other items placed by Block Party participants, may not block fire hydrants.
4. Section 5-3.01 of the Simi Valley Municipal Code prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages in public; this includes front yards as well as the (closed) roadway.
5. Fireworks are prohibited within the City of Simi Valley. Any violations relating to fireworks will make the requested street ineligible for future Block Party permits for a period of five (5) years.
6. The applicant shall clean the all streets and sidewalks at the completion of the event to the satisfaction of the City of Simi Valley.
7. The Simi Valley Police Department and/or the Ventura County Fire Department may terminate the event at any time.
8. The Block Party Applicant and participants shall comply with all Police Department directives related to crowd control, parking and traffic control. The applicant shall be responsible for extraordinary expenses resulting from any unanticipated event related occurrence, which necessitates a response from the Police Department.

This agreement is intended to be part of the original contract of insurance. Failure to perform will establish a prima facie case for breach of contract.
