

## Release for Minor's Commercial Employment Parent/Guardian signature required for all applicants under 18 years of age If over 18 years of age, signature required by YES Client

Except in limited circumstances defined in law, all minors under 18 years of age employed in the State of California must have a Permit to Employ and Work. When required, the minor's school will issue a Permit to Employ and Work. However, the Simi Valley Youth Employment Service (YES) requires that parents/guardians complete the "Release for Minor's Commercial Employment" form. The YES also requires that parents/guardians assist their minor child with employment decisions by:

• Monitoring all arrangements for their employment, i.e., name of employer, address, phone number, transportation to and from the job, and starting and ending time.
