# a. Debrief of the 2014 YES Job and Career Expo

The Board had the following comments and questions regarding the Expo:

More interviews were conducted on-site than in previous years;

Fewer job seekers participated than in the past;

Job seekers were better dressed and prepared than in the past;

The quality of the candidate pool was excellent;

There is still a lack of follow-though by the candidates in that when asked to call an employer after an interview, they didn't;

Updating marketing of the Expo with greater use of electronic media may help get more candidates to participate;

The number of B of A volunteers was double those from previous years and they were a tremendous help;

Low applicant turnout could be related to lower student population in the schools;

Need to reverse the belief that there aren't any/enough jobs offered at the Expo;

Greater participation from the chain department stores would help, maybe corporate should be contacted instead of local managers; and

HR departments are often more inclined to participate.

b. Discuss Informal Presentation Schedule for the 2014-15 School Year

The Board had the following comments about informal presentations:

This year's retail training was excellent;

In preparing for next year's Soft Skills workshops, find existing curriculum from employers, don't reinvent the wheel;

Local caterers are likely to have good Soft Skills training;

This topic should be revisited in September.
